



Memory Verse for January 19-23



Matthew 7:7-8

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

The memory passage for next week is about confidence in prayer. In these verses, Jesus is talking about the confidence that we can have when we pray to the Father by the Spirit in the name of Jesus.

God wants His children to be confident that He indeed hears our prayers and will answer. What's hard sometimes is that God doesn't answer in the time or way that we would like. But God is not like a vending machine, giving us whatever we want automatically. He hears the real need behind the words of our prayers, and answers according to His wisdom, for His glory, and for our good.

Just as part of parenting love is saying, "not yet," or "not in that way," to children, so also God, in His infinite love and wisdom, answers our prayers in His time, in His way. The Christian writer Tim Keller put it this way, "*We can be sure our prayers are answered precisely in the way we would want them to be answered if we knew everything God knows.*" May God give us faith and patience as we pray.

Questions for Discussion

- Can you think of examples of prayers you have seen answered?
- What are you praying for now?

Maintenance Technician Needed

Position Description

Overview

The maintenance technician serves the church and school by contributing to the safe, reliable and cost-effective operation and maintenance of church buildings and grounds. He/she is primarily responsible for implementing and carrying out the preventive and routine maintenance tasks to prolong and ensure appropriate operation of equipment and systems; identifying repair/replacement needs necessary to maintain equipment and systems; and ensuring adequate materials are available to complete assignments in a timely manner. Ideally, this team member will have skill and experience supporting maintenance functions of a business or private entity and will have general knowledge of facility maintenance best practices.

Qualifications

- Must have good interpersonal skills and familiarity w/ SJLC
- Willing to serve
- Attention to detail
- Ability to climb and descend ladders
- Capable of lifting up to 100 pounds
- Preferred
 - 3-5 years facility maintenance experience in a public or private organization
 - General knowledge of building maintenance, carpentry, plumbing and electrical skills
 - Troubleshooting competence

Duties and responsibilities

- Assist with maintaining a preventative maintenance program
- Make basic repairs to:
 - Plumbing equipment
 - Electrical systems
 - Drywall, brick and wood work
 - Light fixtures
 - Hardware (doors, locks, gates, etc)
- Ensure basic fire equipment is operational:
 - Fire extinguishers are regularly inspected
 - Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are routinely checked and batteries properly charged
 - Emergency exit signs are functioning
- Make certain roofs, rain gutters and drains are well-maintained and clear of debris
- Perform basic carpentry including cabinet and furniture repair
- Paint small areas when “touch ups” are needed
- Keep all general storage areas and the workshop area clean and organized
- Regularly inspect church campus and correct/repair and or replace needed items around church
 - Assist facility manager to organize and retain maintenance and/or inspection records
 - Use checklists to systematically (weekly/monthly/quarterly/annually/seasonally) inspect buildings, equipment and real property
- Notify facility manager of discrepancies and other matters requiring additional resources to resolve problems (eg. professional contractor, large financial obligation)
- Complete any other duties as required to sustain a safe, functional and beautiful campus
