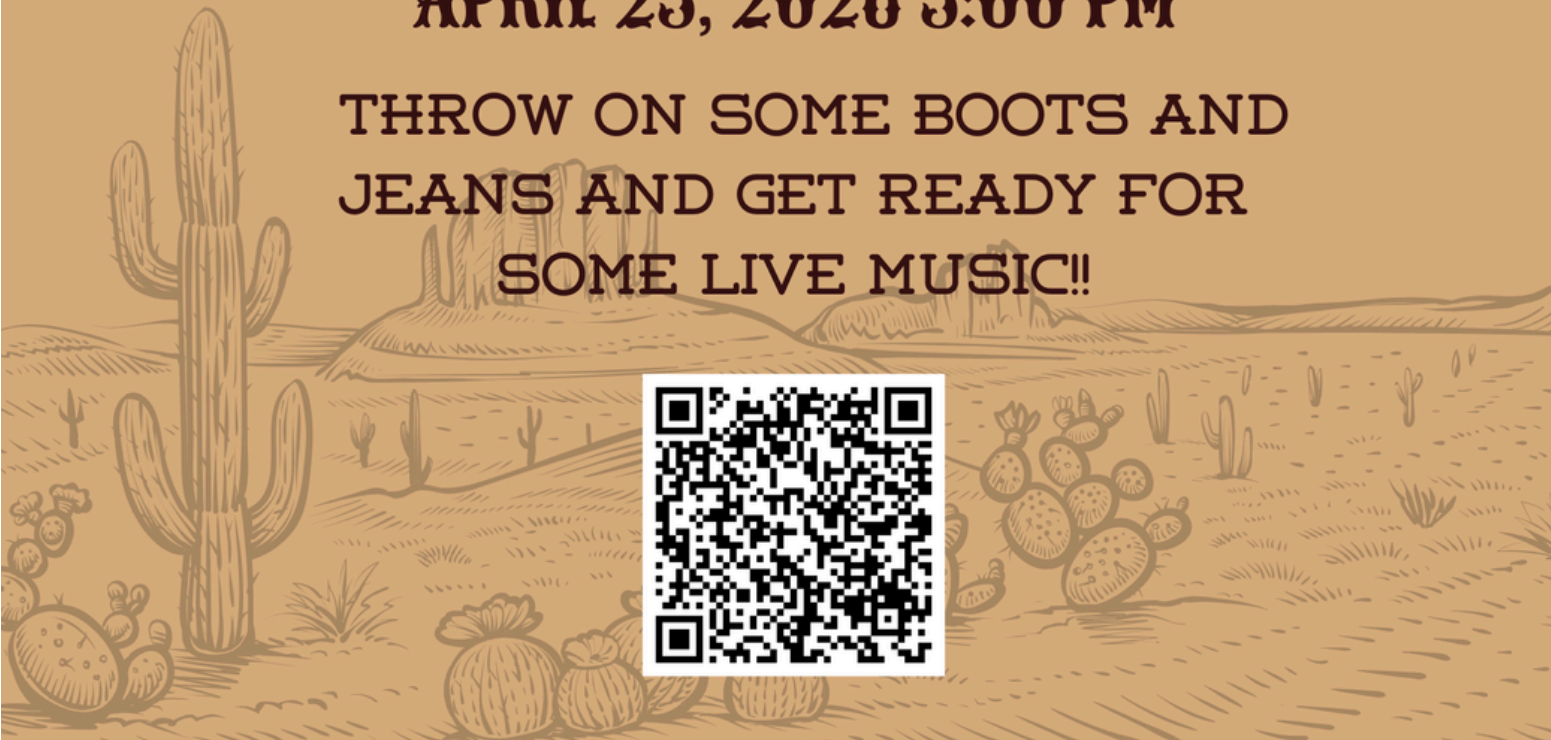

Memory Verse for January 26-30



Philippians 4:6-7 *Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

The memory passage for next week is again about prayer. This passage encourages us to bring everything to the Lord in prayer, especially when we are feeling anxious. No matter the situation, we can trust that the Lord will hear our prayer and answer. In fact, the verse says that we can pray with thanksgiving, already thankful that the Lord will hear, so sure are His promises.

This is followed by a promise of peace. When we turn our anxieties to the Lord, we can have the peace of knowing that we are held in God's hands. Even when we don't know what the answer will be or what the Lord will do, there is peace in knowing that the one who went to the cross for us will surely be with us in whatever challenges we face.
