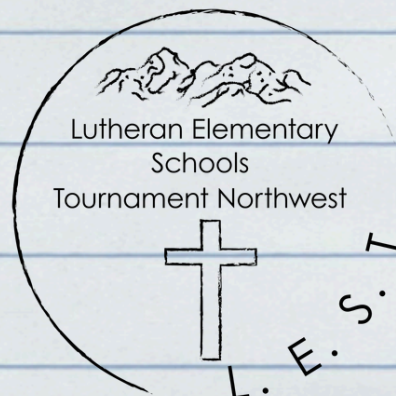

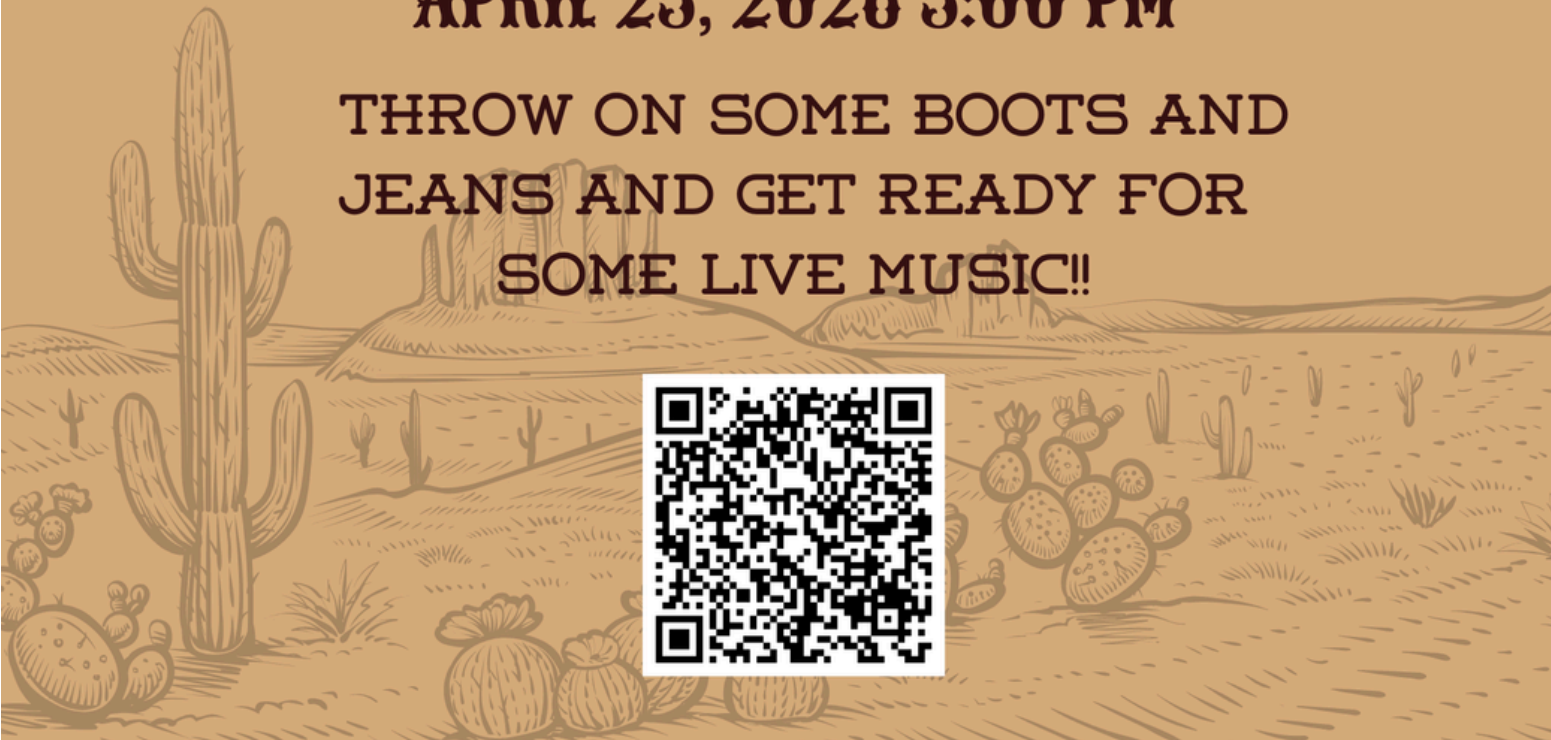

Memory Verse for February 23-27



John 14:6

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

The memory passage for next week is a powerful statement by Jesus about Himself. He identifies Himself not as *a* way, *a* truth, *a* life, but rather *the* way, *the* truth, *the* life.

What does this mean?

- **Jesus is the only way to God:** Jesus is the path that leads us to God. There's no other way to be close to God or to be saved, except through believing in Jesus and what He did for us.
- **Jesus shows us the truth:** Jesus isn't just teaching the truth; He *is* the truth. If you want to know what God is really like, you can look at Jesus because He shows us exactly who God is.
- **Jesus gives us life:** Jesus' life, death, and resurrection give us the gift of eternal life with God. When we believe in Jesus, He promises to give us life forever, even after we die, because He has promised to raise us from the dead.

This verse is very important because it tells us that Jesus is the only way to be saved and live with God forever. You don't have to do anything on your own to be close to God—just believe in Jesus, and He will bring you to God!

Question for Discussion

- Why do you think Jesus wants us to know that He is the way, truth and life?
- How should Christians treat people who might believe other things?
