## Memory Verse for March 17-21



### John 15:5

*I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing*

Imagine a phone without a charger. At first, it works fine, but after a while, the battery runs out, and it can't do anything. In the same way, Jesus says we are like branches, and He is the vine. A branch can only stay alive and grow and bear fruit if it's connected to the vine. If it breaks off, it withers and dies.

Jesus wants us to stay connected to Him. How? By praying, reading the Bible, worshiping, and following His teachings. When we do this, He gives us the strength to love others, be kind, make good choices, and grow in our faith. But if we try to live without Him, we won't be able to do what truly matters.

### Discussion Questions

- What do you think Jesus meant when He said, "Apart from me, you can do nothing"? How does this apply to your daily life?
- What are some things that might cause us to disconnect from Jesus, and how can we stay connected to Him?
