Dear Parent,

Reminder- There is No School tomorrow, Friday, March 27. The teachers will be attending an in-service.

SJL will celebrate Holy Week next week with special activities planned for each day with our Chapel Buddies. Holy Week commemorates the final week of our Savior's journey to the cross and the empty tomb. These are the events that procured our salvation, and that give us the forgiveness and hope that are the foundation of our lives. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday – a celebration of Jesus fulfilling the prophecy from Zechariah with his triumphal entry into Jerusalem. We celebrate Christ as king on Palm Sunday. Maundy Thursday honors the Last Supper, when Jesus established the Lord's Supper. Good Friday is marked by somber reflections on the death of Christ. We are reminded of Jesus' suffering and how powerful our sin is. Jesus took on our sin and experienced the ultimate separation from God so that we will never have to experience that. Holy Week leads up to the celebration of Jesus' triumph over death on Easter Sunday. The Resurrection gives us hope that one day we will also have eternal life with God! We invite you to join in our daily devotion in the Sanctuary at 8:35 am.

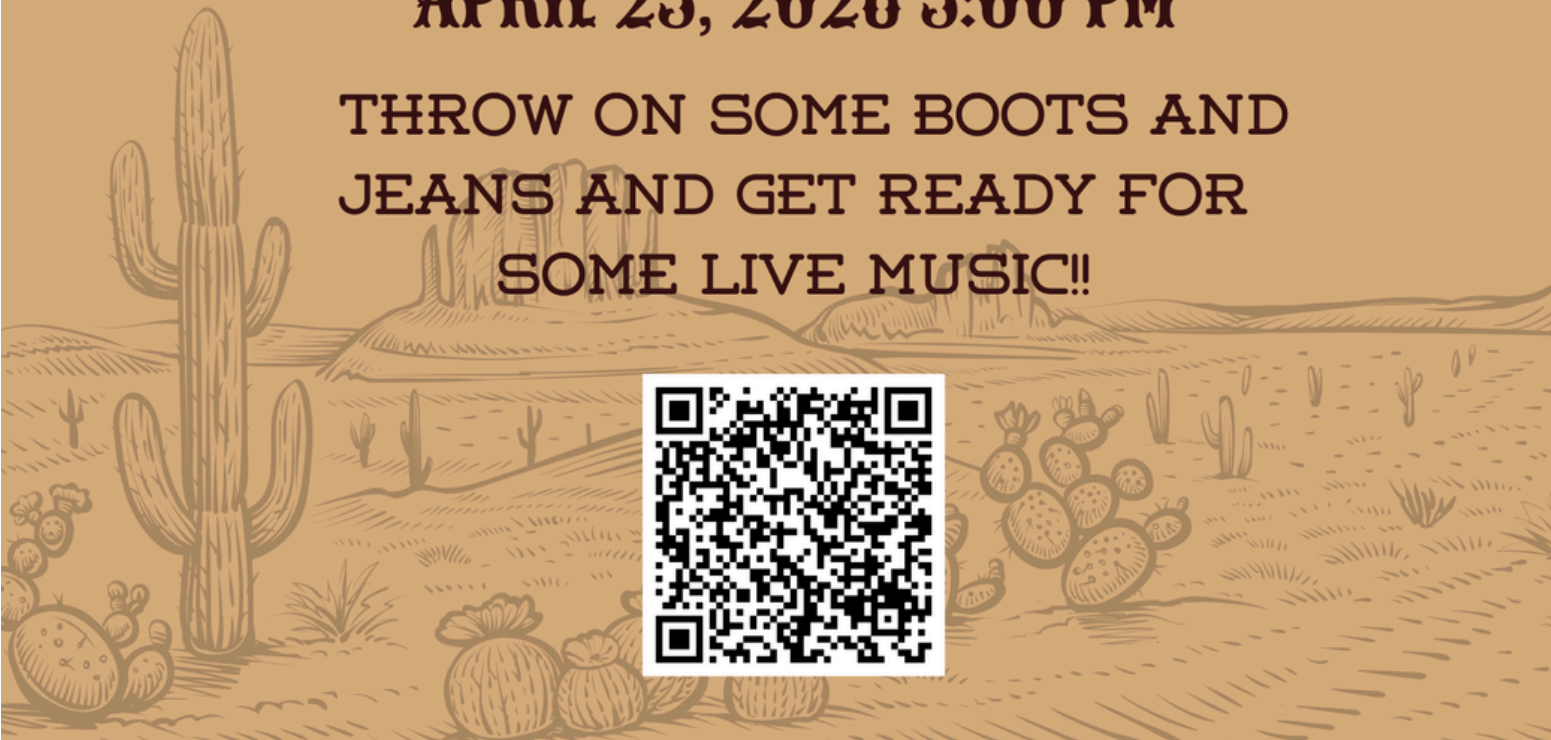

Memory Verse for March 30 – April 3



1 Peter 3:15

But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.

Have you ever had a friend ask you why you go to church or why you believe in Jesus? That's exactly what this verse is talking about! Peter reminds us that we should always be ready to explain our faith. But notice how he says to do it—with *gentleness and respect*. That means we don't argue or try to prove we're better than others. Instead, we kindly share what Jesus has done for us and why we have hope in Him.

So how can we be ready? First, we need to know what we believe. That means reading the Bible, praying, and growing in our faith. Second, we need to live in a way that shows God's love. When people see joy, kindness, and peace in us, they may want to know where it comes from. Then, we get to share about Jesus!

Discussion Questions:

1. If someone asked you why you believe in Jesus, what would you say?
2. What are some ways you can show Jesus' love through your actions this week?

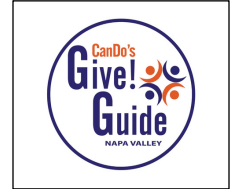

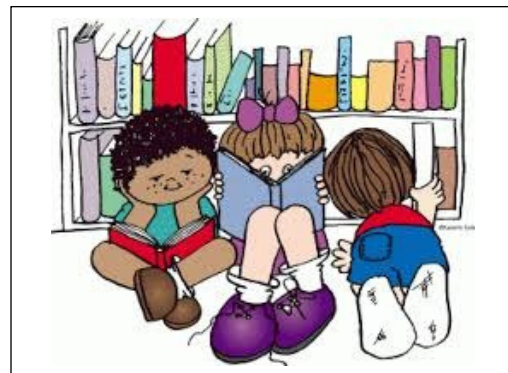

Whether your dancer is brand new or ready for a new challenge, this session is all about growth, confidence, and stepping boldly into the spotlight.

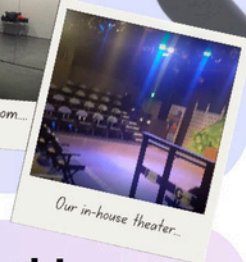
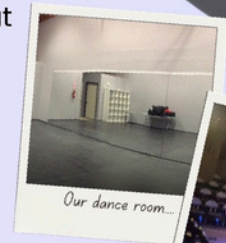

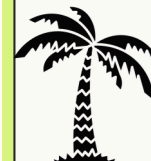
