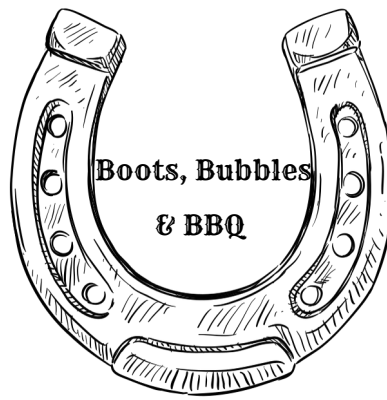

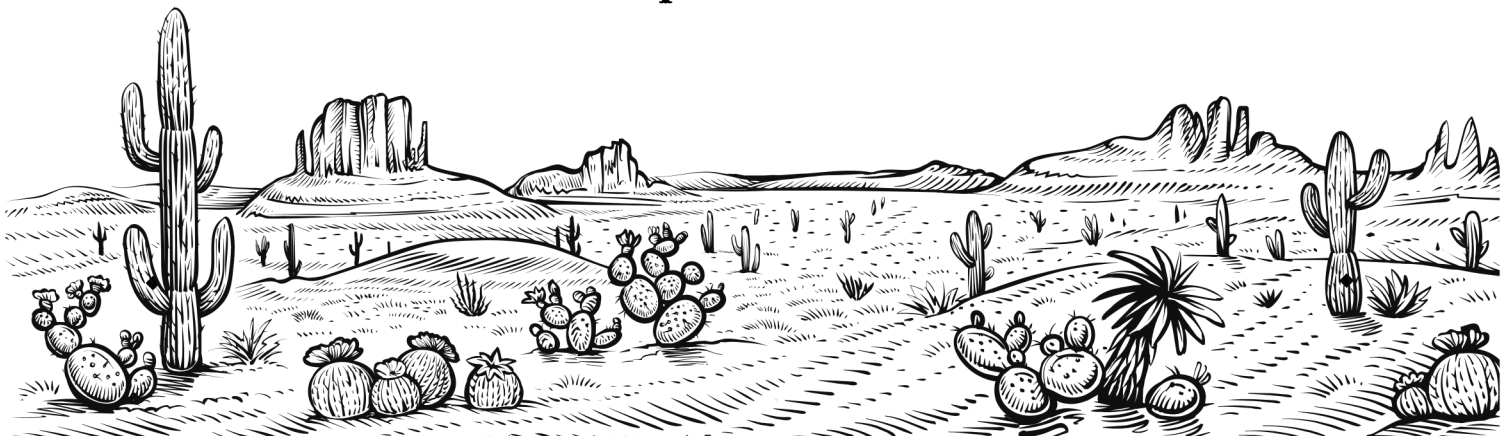

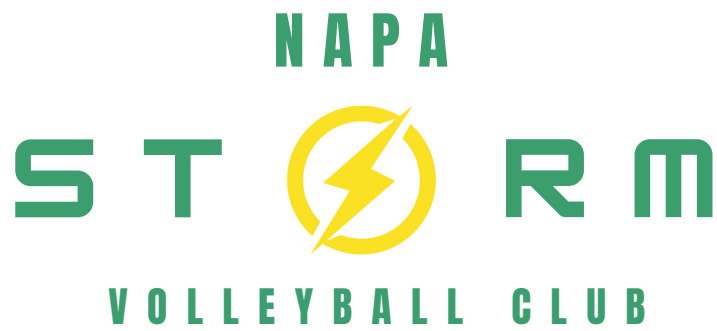

Youth Volleyball Academy

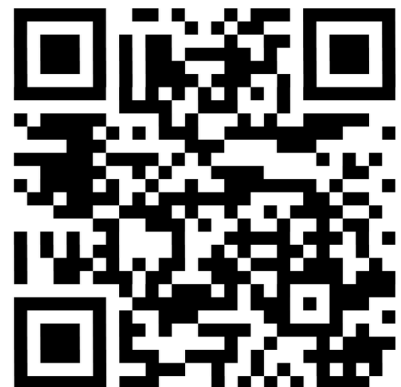

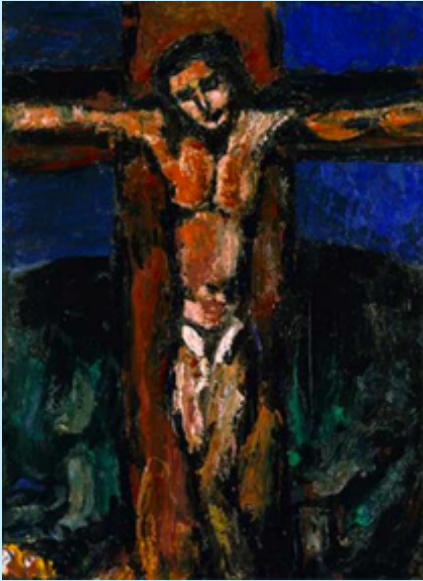

Memory Verse for April 20-24



Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes.

Have you ever felt nervous to talk about your faith? Maybe at school or with friends who don't believe in God? That's totally normal—but here's something amazing: Paul, the guy who wrote this verse, had a lot of reasons to be scared or embarrassed. He was often made fun of, beaten, even thrown in jail for talking about Jesus. But he still said, "I am *not ashamed* of the gospel."

Why? Because he knew something powerful—the gospel (the good news of Jesus) isn't just a nice story. It's the **power of God** that can change people's lives forever. It brings hope, forgiveness, and a relationship with God. That's something worth standing up for!

Even when it's hard, we don't have to be afraid or ashamed. God's with us, and He gives us courage. The truth about Jesus is too good to keep to ourselves.

Discussion Questions:

- What do you think it means to be "ashamed" of the gospel, and why might someone feel that way?

- Can you think of a time when you had the chance to stand up for your faith or talk about Jesus? How did it feel?

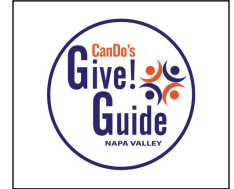

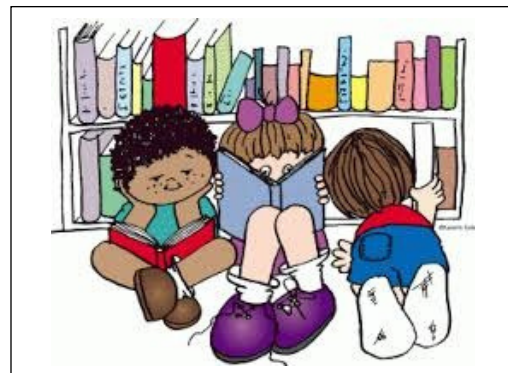
