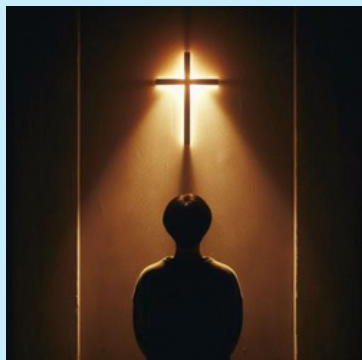

Memory Verse for May 26-29



1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Have you ever had a bad day? Maybe you forgot your homework, had an argument with a friend, or just felt kind of blah. On days like that, it can be really hard to feel joyful or thankful. But guess what? God gives us a reason to *rejoice always*—even on the hard days.

The reason is **Jesus**. Because of Jesus, we know that we are loved no matter what. He died and rose again to forgive our sins and make us part of God's family. That's not just good news—it's the **best** news! That means even when things aren't going our way, we can still find joy in knowing that Jesus is with us.

God also tells us to *pray continually*. That doesn't mean we walk around with our eyes closed and heads bowed all day! It means we can talk to God anytime—when we're happy, sad, worried, or even when we don't know what to say. And because of Jesus, we know God hears us and cares about every word.

And finally, God tells us to *give thanks in all circumstances*. That's not always easy, but it is possible. When we remember how much God has done for us, we start to notice all kinds of blessings—even in tough situations.

Discussion Questions:

1. Can you think of a time when something was hard, but you were still able to find joy or be thankful? What helped you do that?
2. What are some ways you can remind yourself to pray and thank God throughout your day—at school, at home, or with friends?

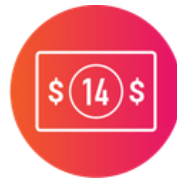
