Memory Verse for May 12-16



Ephesians 4:32

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Have you ever had someone say something mean to you, or maybe you've had a fight with a friend or sibling? It's really easy in those moments to want to get even, ignore them, or hold a grudge. But in

Ephesians 4:32, God gives us a different way to live.

He tells us to be **kind**, **compassionate**, and **forgiving**. That might sound simple, but it can be really tough—especially when someone hurts us. So why should we live this way?

The answer is at the end of the verse: *“just as in Christ God forgave you.”* We forgive because **we've been forgiven**. Jesus took all our sin—every mean thought, every selfish action—and paid for it on the cross. He didn't wait for us to deserve forgiveness; He gave it freely. That's the kind of love He wants us to show others.

Being kind and forgiving doesn't mean pretending bad things didn't happen. It means choosing to let go of anger, just like God did for you. It's not always easy, but with God's help, it's possible.

Discussion Questions:

1. Can you think of a time when someone showed you kindness or forgave you, even when you didn't deserve it? How did that make you feel?
2. What makes it hard to forgive someone? How can remembering what Jesus did for you help in those moments?

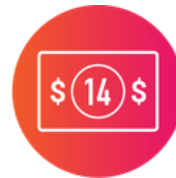
